I am writing regarding CenturyLink's plan to deploy broadband infrastructure in Minnesota through a \$324 million Connect America Fund – Phase II (CAF-II) award.

This investment demonstrates a significant commitment by both CenturyLink and the federal government to increasing economic competitiveness across Greater Minnesota. When complete, CenturyLink's CAF-II buildout of broadband promises to improve connectivity throughout the state for 115,000 homes and businesses making it easier for entrepreneurs to start businesses, students to participate in distance learning and patients and doctors to access high-quality telemedicine.

Given the importance of this project to Minnesota, it is my hope that CenturyLink and its partners quickly reach agreement and resolve any remaining staffing issues to the satisfaction of all parties so that they do not hinder in any way the progress envisioned by the Connect America Fund.
